PREREQUISITES for applying to the International Studies major:
Successful completion of ECON 200, 201 or SIS 123 *AND* either SIS 200 or 201.

In order to evaluate the suitability of applicants for study in the International Studies Program, the Admissions Committee would like each applicant to submit the following materials (*stapled in this order, without covers or packaging*):

- ** 1. A copy of your unofficial UW transcript (a *printer-friendly version from MYUW is OK - see below*). This is also available at Mary Gates Hall or the Registrar's Office (Schmitz Hall).**
- 2. Unofficial or official copies of transfer transcripts from other colleges/universities attended.**
- 3. A one-page statement, typed and double-spaced, responding to the following questions:**
 - What are your personal/educational goals, and how do you expect those to be met through the IS major?
 - What background do you bring to the program?
 - Describe any special experience that would contribute to your studies in this field.
- 4. Writing Sample: A graded copy of a response paper from either SIS 200, 201, or 202.**
- 5. Write your current mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail address in the top right margin of your UW unofficial transcript.**

Submit these materials, **IN THE ORDER STATED ABOVE AND WITHOUT COVERS OR PACKAGING**, to the JSIS Office of Student Services in 111 Thomson Hall.

Deadline: Third Friday of the quarter in which you are applying to the major.
Applications are accepted Autumn, Winter, and Spring Quarters.

****Please do NOT submit the non-printer friendly version of MYUW transcript, it wastes too much paper. You may also ask for an unofficial transcript from one of the locations listed above.**
