An independent jury found Berelowitz's book to be an elegant and accessible investigation into Vancouver's character, urban planning, architecture, public spaces, and landscapes. The book is grounded with the science of an academic text, but still remains a pleasurable and persuasive read. Its alluring design also enhanced its subject – the city of dreams.

Berelowitz was also editor-in-chief of Vancouver's successful 2010 Olympic Winter Games Bid Book submitted to the International Olympic Committee.
