Denis Stevens (BA Honours, Harvard University, 1988; LLB, MBA. McGill University, 1992) was called to the Ontario Bar in 1994. He joined the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade in 1996, where he served as Policy Advisor to the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Deputy Director in the Human Rights Division, and Director of Policy in the Secretariat on War-Affected Children.
