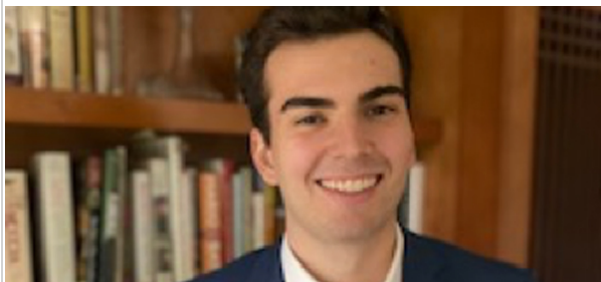
## CANADIAN STUDIES CENTER NEWS

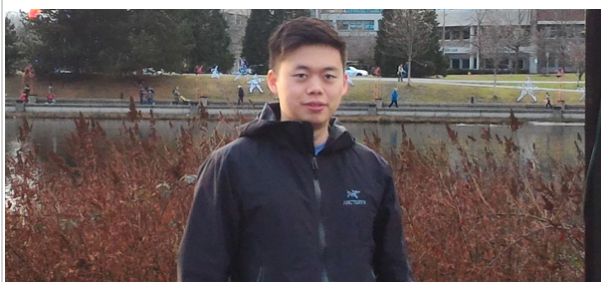
#### **Sam Warkentin, University of Victoria 2018-2019**

I learned how Canada's environmental policy grows out of a historic, political, and cultural context that is different than that of the United States. [MORE](#)



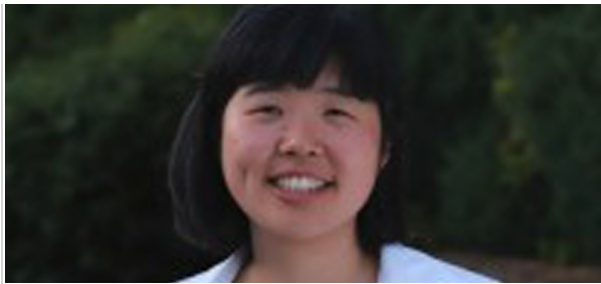
#### **Marissa Darling, University of British Columbia 2017-2018**
