This course will focus on the relationship between literature and history and the politics of culture in the Philippines, Indonesia, and Egypt through a comparative study of the novels of José Rizal, Pramoedya Ananta Toer, and Naguib Mahfouz. It will examine the role of literature in the imagining of national identity under differing colonial and postcolonial conditions. It also takes into consideration the histories of state institutions, cultural communities, and individual writers as participants in the politics of culture. Classes will be a combination of lecture and seminar-style, student led discussions.
