## Communication from the Presidency



### Heads of Government

1. **Proposal to establish a European Information Integrity Office to combat disinformation**

European Information Integrity Office establishment - Proposal to limit foreign interference/destabilization efforts inside the EU by establishing a new European Information Integrity Office, tasked with documenting and regulating the spread of misinformation through primary media outlets, social media and encrypted networks, with the Baltic Region and Finland as a primary area of focus. 2025 funding EUR500m, EUR 4b through 2029

2. **Proposal to create an approval framework for Artificial Intelligence similar to prescription drugs**

AI industry regulation – applying the precautionary principle, the EU will create the world's first SafeAI office, which will regulate and approve Artificial Intelligence products under criteria similar to those used for prescription drugs and medical devices – AI applications will be submitted for specific uses and must be found to be safe and effective for those particular uses by SafeAI-EU before they are made available to the EU public. EUR 250m in 2024, EUR 1B through 2029

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## **Energy Ministers**

### **1. Proposal to create a program to accelerate progress towards 2050 Climate-Neutral EU goals**

Climate Neutral EU 2050 – The European Union will continue to be a world leader in CO2 reduction, reiterating the European Climate Law requirement that the EU as a whole will be Climate-Neutral by 2050. Many EU members are behind on this requirement, particularly in the carbon emissions area. This program of grants will offer the 10 member states with the lowest progress towards 2050 Climate neutrality to access grants totaling EUR 2B annually through 2029 for aggressive reductions in emissions by industries including transportation and energy sectors.

### **2. Proposal for grants to support rural development and green energy outside cities**

Vibrant Rural Communities grants – The European Union supports rural communities and their continued growth and contributions. To enhance both farming communities and those transitioning from agriculture to other economic centers, we propose an EUR 100m annual grant fund, to be divided among the 15 member states with the lowest scores for rural development and green energy usage outside urban areas. EUR 100m total for three years.
