Apply Now for a Seattle-Area Undergraduate Community-Based Internship: January – June 2019

The Carlson Center's Undergraduate Community-Based Internships (UCBI) is a program for University of Washington undergraduate students seeking professional experience with nonprofits and government agencies. During winter and spring quarter, undergraduates will intern 10 hours per week with their host organization. Through their internship and weekly meetings (2 hours), students will reflect on the ways in which power, privilege and oppression influence them, their organizations, and their communities.

As a UCBI participant, you gain:

- The opportunity to work in a project-based internship
- Mentorship and professional development from an onsite supervisor and a Graduate Student Mentor
- \$1,800/quarter educational stipend

Your commitment:

- 10 hours per week with your internship
- 2 hours per week with your UCBI cohort on campus
- A willingness to build community with UW peers participating in UCBI
- An interest in public sector work, but no previous experience is required!
