Once at the stations **(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)** biographical information was entered into the **(b)(7)(E)** **(b)(7)(E)** **(b)(7)(E)** in regards to any applications that may be pending on his behalf. The results of these queries showed no pending petitions.

(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) biographical information, fingerprints, and photo were submitted into the **(b)(7)(E)** **(b)(7)(E)** databases and revealed the above mentioned immigration and criminal history. Additional records checks were conducted through **(b)(7)(E)** based on the results of these databases. This area is not designated as a Port of Entry by the Attorney General of the United States. He thus is present without admission (PWA) by an immigration officer. **(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)** states that he stayed about a month in the San Diego, California area and then boarded a bus and travelled to Denver, Colorado. **(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)** stated that the reason he came to the United States was to find employment.

(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) claims that he does not have any fear of being returned to his native country of Mexico.

I provided **(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)** with his consular rights on March 6, 2017 in the Spanish Language. **(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)** stated that he wished to speak with a member of the Mexican Consulate. On March 6, 2017, at approximately 2030 hours, a phone call was placed to the Mexican Consulate Office in Seattle, Washington. There was no answer with Mexican Consulate and **(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)** left a message.

(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) is being presented for removal proceedings. **(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)** was issued DHS Forms I-826, I-200, I-862 and given a list of free legal service

I went to the back of the bus and, in the English language began to ask each passenger as to his or her citizenship. When I questioned each passenger, I stood at the rear of seat in which the passenger was sitting to allow him or her to depart from the bus if they wished to do so. Approximately half way between the back and the front of the bus, I encountered a subject who was later identified as **(b)(6),(b)(7)(c)** **(b)(6),(b)(7)(c)**. I asked him as to his citizenship in the English language and he replied in a manner that led me to believe that he did not understand me. I restated the question again, and he stated "Liberia." I then asked him if he had any immigration documents to which he answered "yes." **(b)(6),(b)(7)(c)** then gave me a Liberian Passport which had an expired US VISA B-2 from May 15, 2015. He stated that he had paper work pending. I then handed his Passport to Agent **(b)(6),(b)(7)(c)** who ran immigration checks using a handheld **(b)(7)(e)** system. Checks showed no immigration status pending or current. I then instructed him to go to Agent **(b)(6),(b)(7)(c)** who was standing near the front of the bus. **(b)(6),(b)(7)(c)** walked towards Agent **(b)(6),(b)(7)(c)** and the two of them exited the bus. I continued with my inspection and after I had asked the remaining passengers as to their citizenship, I departed the bus.
