## **UW Taiwan Studies Program Conference Paper Travel Grant March 20, 2019**

To encourage and facilitate the presentation of Taiwan-related research at academic conferences, the Taiwan Studies Program announces grants to support conference travel in the amount of \$200.

*Eligibility.* UW PhD student members of the Taiwan Studies Program

*Requirements.* Submitted papers should be (1) Taiwan-related; (2) single- or first- authored; (3) presented at a national or international conference requiring overnight travel.

*Submission.* Submit (1) the paper, and (2) a scan of conference acceptance letter or the conference program title page and relevant panel page. Send as a pdf file to the Taiwan Studies Program at [taiwanst@uw.edu](mailto:taiwanst@uw.edu).

*Timing.* Submit before or after your conference presentation, but no more than two months after.

*Judging.* Submissions will be considered by a committee of the Taiwan Studies Program. Grants will be awarded in the order received. Approximately five award per calendar year are anticipated. Preference will be given to students who have not previously received the Travel Grant.

*Payment.* Payment will be made after the conference. Awardees must be enrolled in the quarter that the funds are disbursed, and have direct deposit on their student account.

Submitted papers will be listed on the Taiwan Studies website. Travel Grant recipients are asked to acknowledge the University of Washington Taiwan Studies Program.
