Actors	<i>Private Sector</i> - Company representatives, industry experts, independent academics
Actions	- Leads neutral, private sector investigations of major state-sponsored cyberattacks to determine attribution.
Authority	- Reputational
Structure	- Decision making done through supermajority voting of member companies in the Executive Council - Expert Investigation Committee leads nation-state cyberattack investigations - Expert Review Committee reviews validity of attribution judgment upon request
Norms	- Peer-review, high transparency, evidentiary framework
Attribution	- Investigation report articulates attribution - The Communications Committee disseminates attribution report, with full transparency, to mainstream news organizations
Budget and Funding Source(s)	- \$40 million for year one and \$30 million/year for subsequent years - Funded by mandatory contributions from member companies
