

## **JSIS Rome 2018 Program Specific Requirements:**

There are certain safety and security measures important to the health and welfare of all students.

**International Travel:** From the beginning of recruitment for this program, and during interviews, students were informed of the travel policy. The language was included on the Study Abroad Web Site as part of the Program Description. **During this study abroad program (from the first to the last day in Rome) students are not be permitted to travel outside Italy.** Consider the Vatican to be inside Italy.

**Travel outside Rome and within Italy:** If travel is planned outside Rome, defined as the Rome National Capital District or Commune, students must fill out and submit a weekend travel information form at least 24 hours before departure. Students should not travel alone inside or outside Rome.

**Maintaining Communication with Program Staff.** All students are required to purchase and maintain an Italian mobile phone number, providing the number to the Program Director by the end of the first week of class. Details on how to purchase the service will be provided on the first orientation day in Rome. Students are required to maintain both e-mail and mobile phone while in Italy, and promptly respond to inquiries from the Program Director. In case of emergency, all students must be able to reach and be reached by the program staff.

Violating or not complying with these program specific requirements can make students subject to discipline under the UW Study Abroad Standards of Conduct (SASC), see Article 25.
