

JSIS Rome 2019 Application Schedule and Information Sessions

The program is now open for applications. The brochure can be found [HERE](#) and students can also access it by going to our [Apply Now](#) page (linked from the Study Abroad homepage).

The application process:

All students studying abroad at UW apply to their programs online through the UW Study Abroad website. The application includes 4 important electronic signature documents covering UW policies and a questionnaire. As soon as your application for **Rome 2019** is complete and has been reviewed, you can be admitted into the program, this will be a “rolling admission” process.

Time line: We are dealing with a very short time line. Students can open an application any time, although the formal application and review process will **close on October 10**.

October 1-4: We will have two information meetings on campus this week, **Tuesday and Wednesday at 5:30 PM in Thompson 317**. Students will also have the opportunity to meet privately with faculty. For those students with completed applications we will announce the first round of admissions this week.

October 8-10: Students will have opportunities to meet with JSIS advisors and program faculty and final review of remaining applications for admission will be completed. For admitted students, contracts will be provided for consideration and signature.

October 15-26: Final decisions on admission and signing of remaining student contracts. Once we have the required number of students we can get program approval from the UW and make final plans for Rome.

If you are considering this program we recommend that you **open an application as soon as possible**, the review process takes a few weeks and we don't have much time. There is **no financial obligation** until you are admitted and have signed a contract.

Finally, if you are in contact with other eligible Jackson School students please **let them know about Rome 2019**, this will help assure that we have enough students (about 20) and that we can get early approval of the program, hopefully in October.
