This class will focus on mixed race identities, ethnicity and gender intersections. We will engage with the history of race and racial hierarchies post-1860s (Meiji Restoration) in Japan and how these ideas have affected the lives of individuals born of mixed race parentage. We will explore intersections with ethnic identities in Japan and America, including their connections to migration and prewar imperialism. Our investigations of historical forms of exclusion and interests in the contemporary practices of resistance in Japan and the U.S. will lead us to look at changes around gender and gender identities, specifically LGBTQ identity and the "Me-too movement" in Japan. The course will be interdisciplinary and ethnographic project based. Students will read and discuss the work of panel participants as well as have opportunities to meet with and interview UW faculty working in similar areas. Students will also participate in the symposium.

We will engage with the history of race and racial hierarchies post-1860s (Meiji Restoration) in Japan and how these ideas have affected the lives of individuals born of mixed race parentage.
