

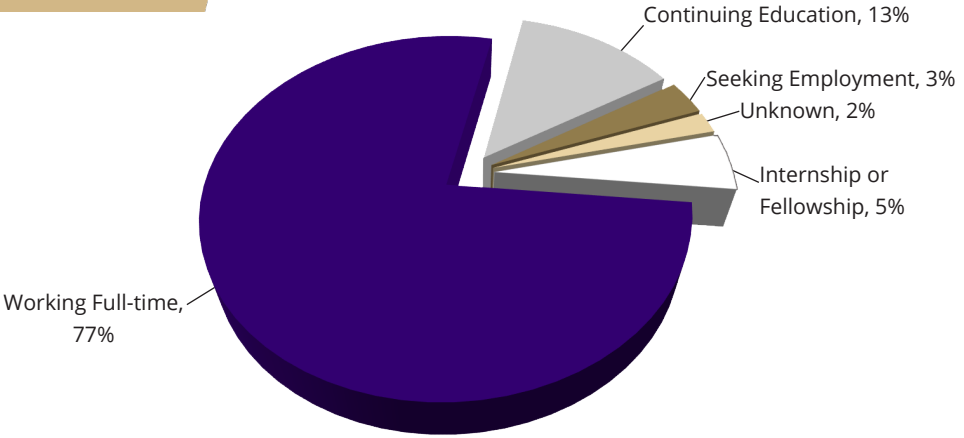

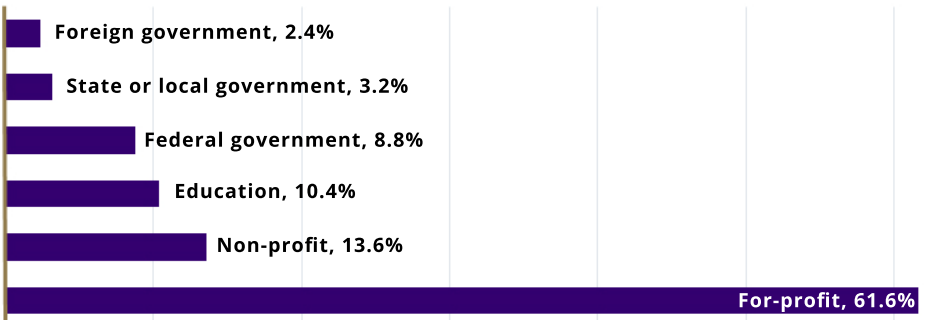
Graduates employed or continuing education within 6 months of graduation*

Class of 2018 sectors

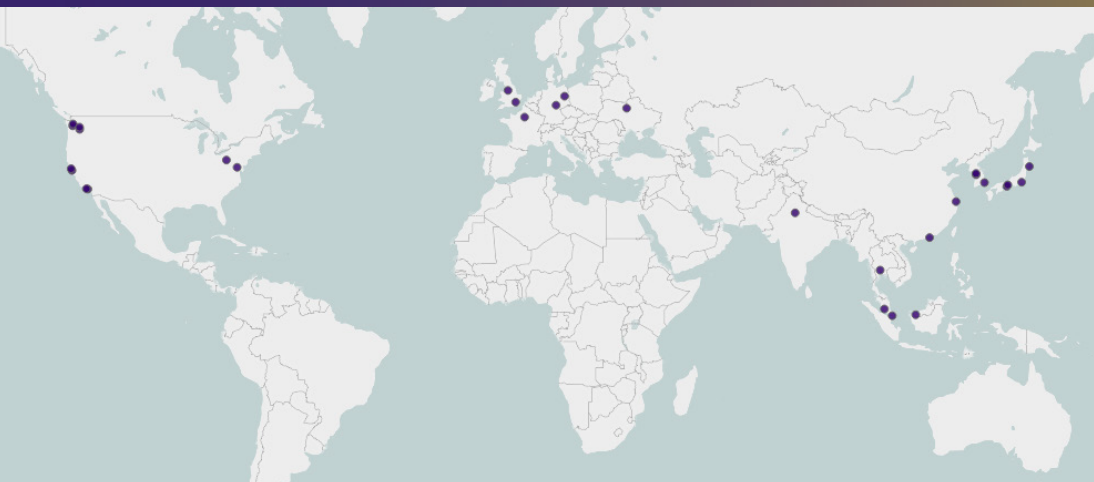


Graduate programs they are pursuing
