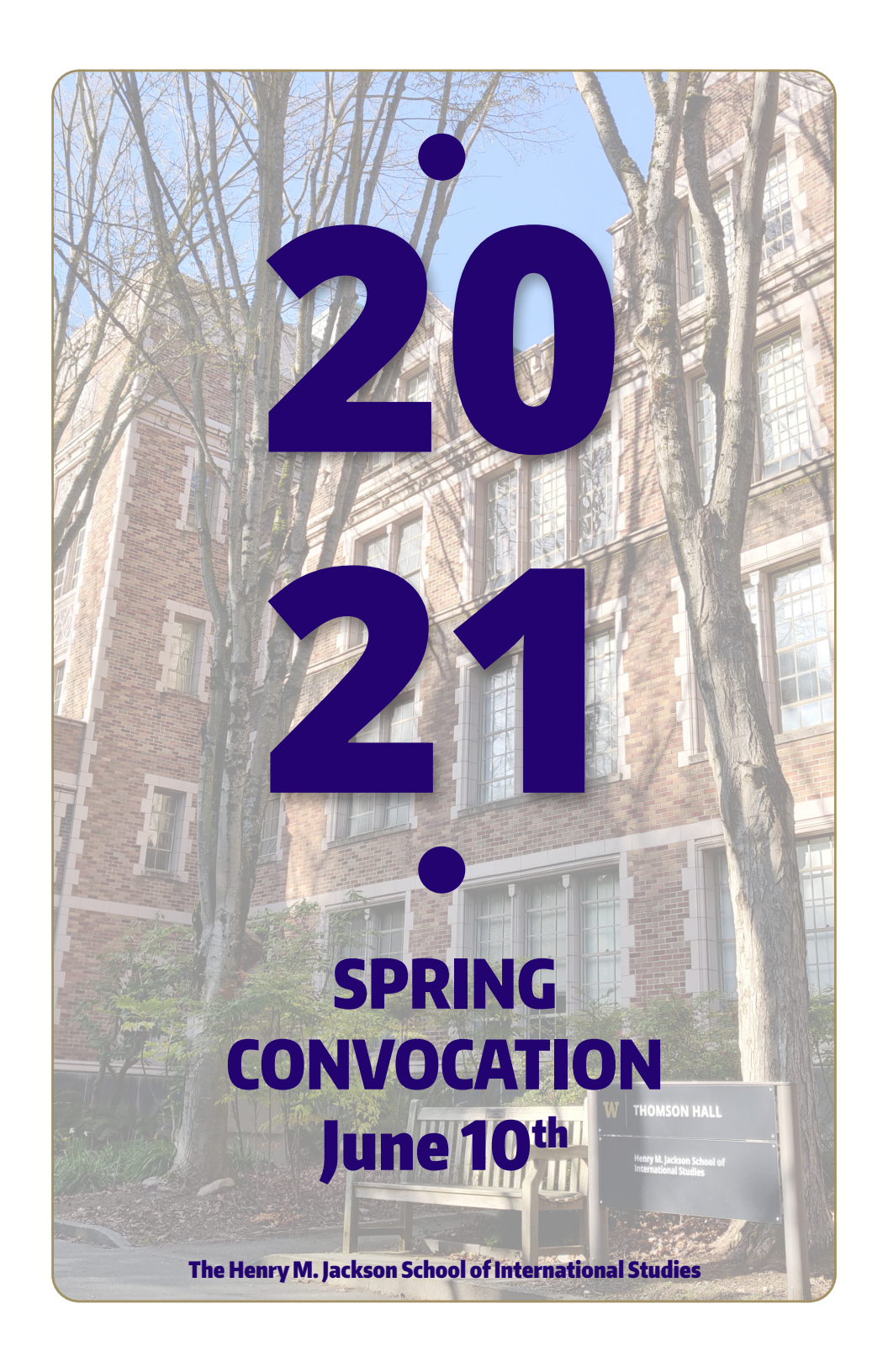

Annah Mwendar-Chaba is a Foreign Service Officer with the U.S. Department of State. Her specialty area is Public Diplomacy, and she is stationed in Virginia at the Foreign Service Institute.

As a proud first generation American and second generation UW graduate, Annah followed her immigrant parents' footsteps to the UW. She received her Honors B.A. at the Jackson School of International Studies in 2014 and her M.A. at Columbia University School of International and Public Affairs in 2017.

Annah's interest in international studies started at an early age with family trips to Kenya. At the Jackson School, she thrived academically and socially, studying abroad in Paris and becoming the 2013 UW Homecoming Queen. Annah received the Jackson School Leadership Award, as well as the prestigious Charles B. Rangel International Affairs Graduate Fellowship. Her Jackson School capstone project focused on USAID, addressing issues in education, food security, and health.

Annah's past work included positions at U.S. Embassies in Port Louis, Mauritius, and New Delhi, India, Bloomberg Philanthropies, the United Nations, U.S. House of Representatives, and World Affairs Council. Annah's next tour will be in Jerusalem, where she will add her skills in Arabic to her extensive knowledge of Kiswahili, French and Hindi.
