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### Euro Challenge 2024

The Euro Challenge is a competition on European economic policy for 9th and 10th-grade students across the United States. After competing in regional contests, 25 teams are invited to participate in the semi-finals and final round in New York City.

### How does the challenge work?

Student teams work on a presentation about the overall economics of the euro area and a specific economic challenge faced by a member state. They become the policymakers to consider solutions to a topical economic issue and give a 15-minute presentation in front of expert judges.

### Why participate?

Participants learn about the euro, the EU Single Market, and other important concepts central to the European Union and international economics. It's also a great opportunity to develop research, team-working, and presentation skills.

Twenty-five teams attend the semi-final and final rounds in New York City, where they present to diplomats and economic experts. The top two teams win a trip to Washington, D.C., where they deliver their presentations to embassy officials from the member state they analysed and visit the EU Delegation to the U.S. headquarters.
