Voting faculty discussed a confidential personnel case and approved the recommendations of the search committee for the Professor of Practice hire. The vote was 27 Yes 1 No 3 Abstain

At 10:15 the full faculty discussed hiring requests for AY 2022/2023. Faculty discussed the ranked hiring priorities of Media, Technology & Data and Political Economy Development from the 2021-2022 hiring plan. Faculty on the environmental justice/development search committed indicated that the short list presented strong connections with the field of development studies. Faculty voiced support for changing the order and prioritizing a search on Media, Technology and Data. No opposition was voiced. Faculty also supported applying for the Provost initiative on the data science major in conjunction with this hiring priority. Faculty asked for this new ranking to be included in the electronic vote language. This change was made and the faculty voted unanimously in support of the hiring plan. The vote was 30 Yes, 0 No, 0 abstain.

Tony Lucero chair of the Environmental Justice/Development reported on the status of this tenure track faculty search.
