This workshop will be conducted in French and is open to educators and students in teaching certificate programs or French-language programs. The workshop will include presentations on nationalism in Québec, teaching Québécois French in the classroom, and French-Canadian *chansons à réponses* as a method for teaching French, as well as a performance of traditional Québécois music by La Famille Léger.
