Narrative

Report Title: Hunger Strike Northwest Detention Center (b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) August 15, 2018, at or about 1130 AM PST, ICE detainee (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) 23 year-old national of Russia, declared a hunger strike after missing his fourth meal (lunch). At that time (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) claimed he would not consume any liquids as well. After his declared hunger strike (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was placed in medical isolation for evaluation and monitoring. On August 18, 2018, at or about 0630 AM PST, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) missed his 9th consecutive meal (breakfast) at the Northwest Detention Center (NWDC) in Tacoma, WA causing his hunger strike to become official. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) as refused to answer questions by medical staff so it is unknown how long he has refused liquids. IHSC staff and ICE management continue to monitor his case.

On August 17, 2018, during a mental health evaluation, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) stated his reason for hunger strike because he desires to be released and has difficulty with detainment. Additionally (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) stated another reason for his hunger strike is because he does not want to go back to Russia.

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was taken into DHS custody on May 28, 2018 after applying for admission at the Calexico Port of Entry. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was found to be inadmissible to the United States. During inspection (b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) On May 31, 2018 (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was transferred to ICE custody at FCI

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Sheridan in Oregon. On June 20, 2018, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was transferred to the Northwest Detention Center, Tacoma, WA for medical treatment for exposure to scabies and to better monitor what appeared to be the beginning of meal refusals. It was reported that (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) had not eaten any meals in four to five days due to depression. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) (b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was served a parole advisal (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) returned the necessary supporting documents for consideration of parole. The parole decision is pending (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) formal decision by local ICE management, and a decision will not be rendered while (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) remains on hunger strike.
