Narrative

Report Title: Northwest Detention Center / Seattle AOR - Detainee Suicide Attempt

On November 15, 2018, at 3:16 PST, GEO staff at the Northwest Detention Center alerted ERO Seattle that an IMS had been called after detainee (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) a 40-year-old citizen of Russia, was discovered attempting self-harm by strangulation. The Tacoma Fire and Rescue paramedics responded, initiated cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and transported (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) to Saint Joseph's Hospital in Tacoma, WA, where he remains in the ICU and his condition is unstable.

Immigration and Criminal History:

On December 2, 2017, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) applied for admission with a valid Russian passport at the San Ysidro, CA Port of Entry (POE). (b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) determined (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) to be inadmissible pursuant to section 212(a)(7)(A)(i)(I) of the Immigration and Naturalization Act (INA), as amended, as an immigrant without immigrant visa, and (b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

On December 6, 2017, CBP transferred (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) to ERO San Diego custody at the San Luis Regional Detention Center.

On February 1, 2018, an immigration judge (IJ) in Tacoma, WA determined the court had no jurisdiction in a custody hearing due to (b)(6); being an arriving alien.
 On February 7, 2018, ERO Seattle served (b)(6); a Parole Advisal and Scheduling Notification.
 On February 26, 2018, ERO Seattle denied (b)(6); parole due to posing a risk of flight.

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

ordered (b)(6); removed to Russia. (b)(6); reserved appeal, which was due by September 6, 2018.

On August 22, 2018, (b)(6); declared himself to be on hunger strike and IHSC began monitoring his meals.

On August 25, 2018, (b)(6); declined his ninth consecutive meal and IHSC initiated hunger strike protocol.

On September 6, 2018, ICE obtained a medical monitoring/force hydration order from the United States District Judge. (b)(6); began drinking Pedialyte and allowing medical monitoring. (b)(6); also began drinking boost nutritional shakes and eating pieces of fruit.

On September 19, 2018, ERO Seattle scheduled (b)(6); for an escorted commercial removal with his valid Russian passport for October 24, 2018.

On October 1, 2018, (b)(6); filed an untimely notice of appeal with the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA). ERO Seattle cancelled (b)(6); scheduled removal.

On October 16, 2018, (b)(6); consumed a full meal and IHSC declared an end to official hunger strike protocol.

On November 2, 2018, the BIA dismissed (b)(6); appeal as having been filed untimely.

On November 8, 2018 ERO Seattle scheduled (b)(6); for an escorted commercial removal to Russia on November 28, 2018.

On November 15, 2018, at approximately 3:06 P.M PST, GEO contract staff at the Northwest Detention Center observed (b)(6); in his cell in the restricted housing unit, causing self-harm by self-induced strangulation and initiated the Incident Management System (IMS).

On November 15, 2018, at approximately 3:09 P.M PST, ICE Health Service Corps (IHSC) arrived and began administering CPR to (b)(6);

On November 15, 2018, at approximately 3:29 P.M..PST, paramedics reported that (b)(6) had a pulse and transported him to Saint Joseph's Hospital in Tacoma, WA.

On November 15, 2018, at 3:42 P.M. PST, ERO Seattle notified ERO HQ Field Operations of (b)(6); suicide attempt.

On November 15, 2018, at 5:31 P.M.. PST, IHSC notified ERO Seattle that (b)(6); had no brain activity and was pending additional testing.

ERO Seattle and local IHSC are carefully monitoring the case; Seattle OCC has been made aware of the case and is also monitoring.

Acting Field Office Director (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) reviewed and approved the SIR.

Narrative

Report Title: SAAPI incident at NORCOR

On November 15, 2018, at 1647 hours, officials at the Northern Oregon Regional Correctional Facility (NORCOR) notified officials with Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Enforcement and Removal Operations (ICE ERO), Seattle Field Office, Portland Sub-office, of a PREA event that occurred at NORCOR on November 10, 2018, between 2043 and 2047 hours, with ICE detainee (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) sexually harassing ICE detainee (b)(6); (b)(7)(C).

NORCOR is an IGSA facility that houses 25-50 ICE detainees on any given day.

On November 14, 2018, at approximately 1240 hours, NORCOR officials report that (b)(6); (b)(6); submitted a request to speak with NORCOR officials regarding a PREA incident.

On November 15, 2018, at approximately 1120 hours, a NORCOR corrections sergeant received that request.

On November 15, 2018, at approximately 1238 hours, that NORCOR corrections sergeant and a lead corrections deputy removed the alleged victim, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C), from the 400 housing unit at NORCOR and spoke with him privately, in his native language, Spanish, to obtain a statement of the incident. The lead deputy then had (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) complete a
