Uli Fischer is the Honorary Consul for Germany and has served in this position since April 2017. In this function, he promotes economic, cultural and political relations between the states of Washington, Montana and the Federal Republic of Germany.

Uli is the local representative to German citizens residing in Washington and Montana. In this function he assists with a variety of official documentation requirements, including passports applications.

Mr. Fischer retired after more than 30 years with the Commercial Airplane Division of The Boeing Company. During his time at Boeing, he has held various positions ranging from airplane programs, supply chain management, strategy development and airplane sales. Prior to joining Boeing, Uli worked in aircraft maintenance for the West-German Air Force and at Pan American World Airways in New York.
