Eligibility

- 1-2 page statement of graduate research activities and plans for the 2017-18 school year (please indicate your major or degree program and estimated date of completion as well as how the funding will help support your degree and research goals)
- 1 letter of recommendation from your primary advisor
- Transcripts from UW and previous institutions
